Homework Task	Date Completed
1. Share some baby photographs with your grown-ups. Talk about things you can do now that you could not when you were a baby. Write 5 'I can' sentences to show what you can do, eg: I can run fast, I can hop, I can right a bighc.	
2. Investigate how an egg hatches and a chick is born. (There are great Youtube videos which demonstrate this.) Draw a chart to show how this happened: egg - incubator - hatching day - chick! Try to label your drwaings.	
3. Find out and write 3 facts about a seahorse or a starfish. Draw your best picture of Sandy or Sammy.	





Using junk materials or crafts or play dough make a 3D model of a beautiful butterfly.

4. Read 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'. Make a diagram picture to show how a caterpillar turns into a beautiful butterfly. Use your sounds to label your picture.

5. Have a counting session! Show your grown-up that you can:
Count to 20 forwards.
Count to 20 backwards.
Count in 10's to 100
Count in 2's to 20.

6. Draw a beautiful flower. Use the knowledge you already have, and research if you're not sure, to label your drawing with the following words: stem, leaf, flower and root. Find out what a plant needs to grow.

7. Go for a lovely long walk or have an extra close look in your garden. Make a list of everything you can see that grows! Use all of the sounds you know in order to write your words.
