









Include keys facts: location, capital city, population, climate, highest mountain, interesting facts etc.</p>	<p>Task C</p> <p>What was the Trojan Horse? Write a short newspaper report on purple mash explaining what happened?</p>	<p>Task D</p> <p>Create a new and unique mythical creature; name it and annotate the features.</p> 	<p>Task E</p> <p>Create an Ancient Greek vase. Research what they looked like – remember that the vases often told stories. You can draw a vase, make it from clay etc – you decide!</p>	    
	<p>Task F</p> <p>Write your own Greek Myth. Remember that there must be a problem to overcome not just the monster, i.e. The maze from Theseus and the Minotaur.</p>	<p>Task G</p> <p>Ancient Greek Fashion: what did the Ancient Greeks wear? What was their jewellery like? Draw and label a typical ancient Greek outfit.</p>	<p>Task H</p> <p>Compare two of the most important city states of Ancient Greece, Athens And Sparta. How were they similar and different?</p>	<p>Task I</p> <p>Theatre was an important aspect of life for the Ancient Greeks. Therefore, can you create a mask that could have been worn by an actor in Ancient Greece? It could be a character form a myth or a God /Goddess. (Masks often exaggerated facial features / emotions – you may need to do a little research).</p>	<p>Task J</p> <p>Make a model of a Greek Temple. Think about the different materials you may need and why you have chosen them.</p>	
	<p>Task K</p> <p>What is your favourite Greek myth? Create a PowerPoint presentation to try and persuade others to read this myth.</p>	<p>Task L</p> <p>The Ancient Greeks created the Olympic Games, pick one event that has been in the Olympics since its inception and plot the World Records on a graph.</p>	<p>Task M</p> <p>Find out about the Spartan Army. Why was it considered the best? Then create a poster to encourage parents to send their children for training.</p>	<p>Task N</p> <p>Create a mosaic that would be on the wall or floor of a Greek temple. It could be for any of the Gods, what colours should you use and designs for your chosen God?</p>	<p>Task O</p> <p>Wildcard! Create your own task which is linked to the Ancient Greeks.</p>
