Dear parents/carers,

Following the Prime Minister's statement last night, I am sure you will have many unanswered questions. We have lots of questions that need clarification too.

Currently, for us in school, there is no change to the guidance relating to COVID-19. We will continue to provide care for vulnerable pupils and the pupils of those parents who have been deemed as Key Workers. Current government advice remains that, if possible, it is safer to stay at home.

As yet, schools have not received any additional information or guidance to support the proposed phased reopening of primary schools in June, beginning with Reception, Year1 and Year6 classes. We expect that we will receive further clarification from the DfE in due course. We will need clear guidance from the government, teaching unions and the local authority in order to plan effectively how to manage and maintain social distancing in schools, in order to keep our children, staff and families safe.

As always, I will keep you informed of any developments, as and when these arise, but for now, please try not to worry. Our aim is to continue to provide home learning activities online and to keep in contact with you via our school website, school app and Parentpay.
