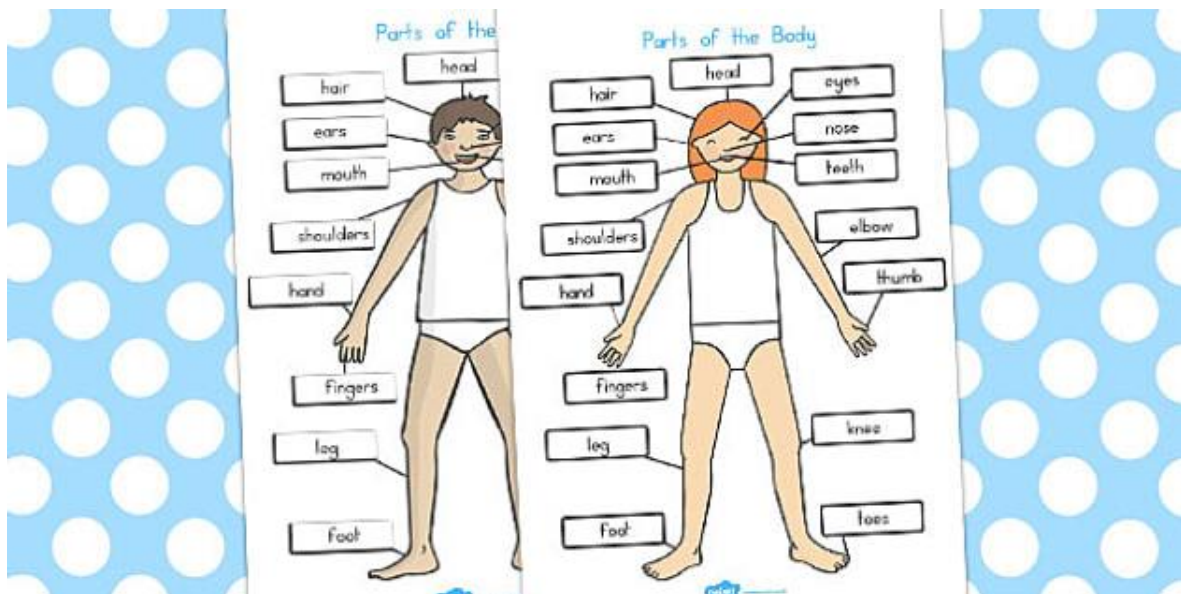


Reception Activities - Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July

Literacy: Today we are we are drawing pictures of ourselves and labelling them



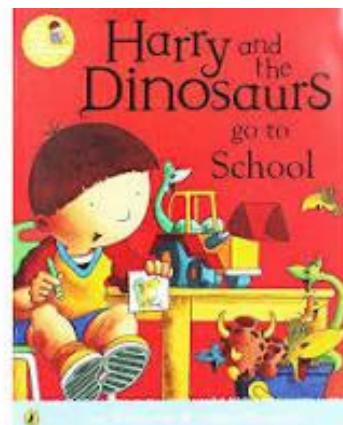
Can you write the labels using your sounds eg knee - nee, , eyes - ighs.
