## Writing Unit Structure

Each writing unit has a balance of experience lessons, sentence stacking, and independent writing lessons to build upon skills and prior knowledge. The number of days covered within each unit will vary depending on the genre or text type.

## Reading

Reading is taught over a weekly cycle. Book Talk is used at the beginning of the week to encourage reading discussion, form opinions and explain answers orally. Whole class reading allows specific teaching of reading strands within a context or theme each week. At the end of the week, pupils apply skills independently in a new context. In LKS2, reading fluency is practised through a repeated read of the text over three sessions. All children will take part in choral, echo or partner reading to practise fluency.
